The Governing Board subscribes to the philosophy that it is the school's responsibility to develop children's abilities to their fullest, both physically as well as mentally. The Board also believes that competitive sports activities not only improve a child's physical well-being, but also enhance school spirit and student morale. Therefore, the Board directs the Superintendent or designee to implement a program of sports activities within and between the district's schools whenever such activities are deemed to be in the best interest of the students and are financially feasible.
