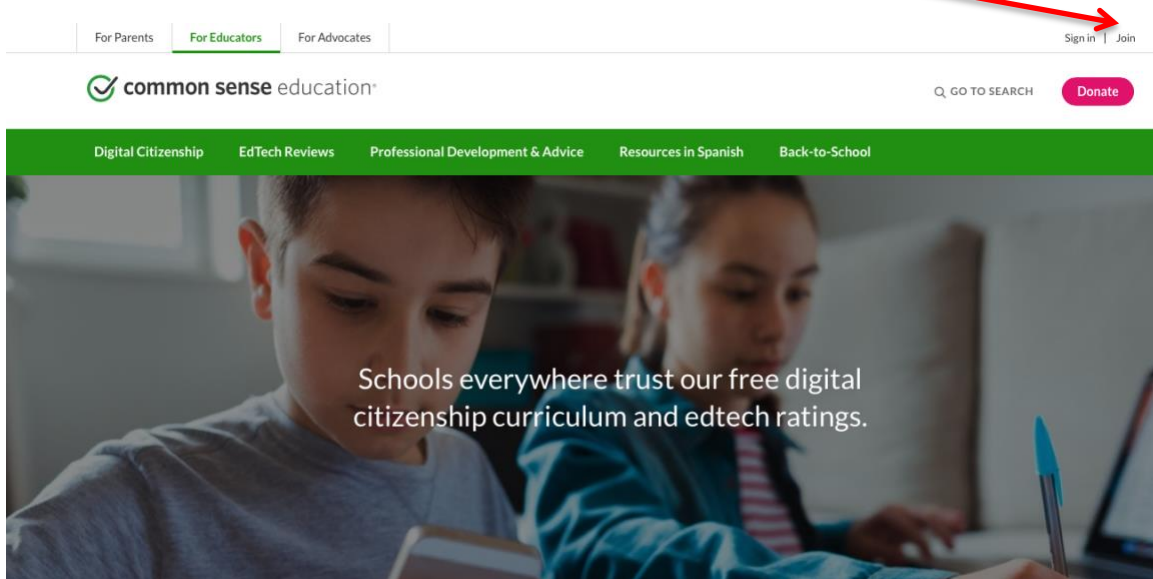


Directions for Creating Common Sense Media Teacher Account

Step One: Go to commonsense.org/education/


Step Two: Click "Join" in the top right-hand corner.



Step Three: Enter your district email and create a password.
